Welcome Students to Elements which offers and interesting finishing to your work. You can leave it as piece of needlework and finish it as a pillow, place it in a tray or have it framed.

However, I am offering it finished as a Snap Tray, with finishing instructions included.

I am including a supply list of materials on the following page in two different colour ways that I used. However, you are welcome to switch the colours to your own colour palate. Nevertheless, do try and keep the same weights of the threads. For example #5 Perle Cotton and Vineyard Silk can be interchanged easily. Soie Cristale and be changed for Soie d'alger or even DMC Floss.

Use Watercolours (Overture) as your guide for choosing all the other fibres. Watercolours offers an easy way of putting a colour palate together. Open the skein so you can view what colours are in thread and then choose your Perle cottons, braids, etc. Since it is a hand dyed thread you may have to adjust the colours from what I have suggested, due to dying differences.

The crystals listed may not be available anymore, but there are other crystals that can be used, so I recommend that you go to a bead store with your fibres and the materials list to match up your colour list. I would wait until I had completed the piece before purchasing the backing fabric.

A Stitching Shop in Denver, CO has made kits for this course before and if you want one of the two colours I have listed I am sure Christine would be very willing to assist you.

My other piece of advice is when you receive your first lesson either print the **Outline Chart** on a 17" by 11" piece of paper or have it printed at your favour printers. Since it is the outline of your design and you do want to read it with ease, you may want it even larger!

Information for Elements is on Page 3. With your first lesson you will receive some general information and a Section called **Stitching for Perfection**, which contains many helpful tips. The instructions are a total of 43 pages plus overall chart. They are divided in a total of 4 Lessons and each Lesson will contain those instructions.
